The Pasteur Foundation Award

This award recognizes individuals who have demonstrated an outstanding devotion to improving public health worldwide. This year we honor **Franck Riboud** and **Professor Muhammad Yunus**.

Our relationship with Danone, the parent corporation of The Dannon Company, is a long one, starting in 1919 when Danone's founder, Isaac Carasso, developed the first industrially produced yogurt based on the work of Pasteur Nobelist Elie Metchnikoff, and the necessary cultures were provided by the Institut Pasteur. A faithful philanthropic partner of the institute, Mr. Riboud is the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Danone. Professor Yunus is the founder of Grameen Bank and the 2006 recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize. The Chairman of the 2006 Norwegian Nobel Committee noted that "lasting peace cannot be achieved unless large population groups find ways in which to break out of poverty." In their efforts to find such ways, Franck Riboud and Muhammad Yunus have formed a remarkable joint venture, Grameen Danone Foods, Ltd. This social-business enterprise aims to alleviate poverty and provide a reliable source of nutritious dairy products in rural Bangladesh. Our 2010 award recognizes their commitment to this innovative partnership's mission to improve the human condition. Mr. Riboud and Professor Yunus join a very distinguished group of awardees that includes President Nelson Mandela and President William J. Clinton.

Institut Pasteur

For over 120 years, the Institut Pasteur has remained true to the vision of founder Louis Pasteur in fostering excellence in biomedical research on its Parisian campus and in providing training and services, such as epidemiological surveillance and vaccination. Ten Pasteur scientists have been awarded the Nobel Prize. A private nonprofit organization, the institute is internationally recognized for its work on infectious diseases, including AIDS, malaria, tuberculosis, influenza, shigellosis and certain cancers. In 1983 and 1985, respectively, Pasteur researchers isolated HIV1 and HIV2. Thanks to its Paris labs and a network in thirty countries, the institute is well positioned to address the threat of emerging diseases, such as the recent H1N1 flu.

Pasteur Foundation

A 501(c)(3) organization, the Pasteur Foundation actively nurtures Franco-American scientific exchange and raises funds for infectious disease research. Its **Postdoctoral Fellowship program**, **Undergraduate Internship program**, and **Visiting Scholars program** all bring talented U.S. researchers to work in Pasteur laboratories. By supporting the Pasteur Foundation, Americans aid a cause benefiting the health of individuals throughout the world while extending scientific opportunities to U.S. scientists.
